# *Keeping Families Together*

## ***What Is Hands of Hope?***

This program is designed for families who reside in Clark, Floyd or Harrison Counties, who qualify for intensive community support.

First, we help you identify your family's unique strengths and resources. Together we look to see what emotional, educational and social needs your child has. The third step is to help you find the resources to meet those needs.

Our goal is to help your child stay in your home. We will do this by coordinating with you and multiple agencies, accessing community resources, to "wrap around" their services and help you develop the skills you need to support your child.

The Wraparound Coordinator will be contacting you soon to set up a strength discovery interview with you and your family.

## ***Why Has My Child Been Referred To This Program?***

Each child has their own unique reasons for being referred to this wraparound program.

To qualify for this program your child must:

- A.) Live in Clark, Floyd or Harrison County or be returning to Clark, Floyd or Harrison County through reunification or discharge plans.
- B.) Be under 18 years of age.
- C.) Have one of the following:  
An Individualized Education Plan (IEP) or  
A significant behavioral issue that causes persistent problems with friends, family members, peers and/or teachers at school.

This referral provides you with an opportunity to work as a member of your child's Care Team. Your involvement is a crucial part of your child's success today and in the future.

## ***What Happens?***

You will be informed that your child has been referred to a "Systems of Care" program. An interview will be arranged with you to discover your family's strengths. This is different from most interviews because it focuses on positive features, relating to you and your family. You, along with the facilitator, will identify who will be the members of your team. This team will work with you to identify specific goals. Regular meetings will then be set up to provide you with the support you need to help you and your child meet the goals you have set.

## ***How Much Will It Cost?***

Wraparound services are funded through the Systems of Care Teams. Hoosier Healthwise also provides coverage for some of the services for eligible families. Counseling services are available for sliding scale fees that are determined by income eligibility or services may be covered by your healthcare insurance. Specific services may involve a cost to you, such as after school care or therapeutic activities. The Wraparound Coordinator will work with you to access community resources and help you fit the needed services into your budget.

## ***What You Will Need***

You will need the motivation it takes to improve your present situation and a strong desire for a better future for both you and your children. Determination and persistence is necessary to continue working toward the goals you and the team set.
