<u>Assessment</u>: LifeSpring's staff of professionals will ensure that you receive a complete evaluation which will help identify any concerns you have and will help you set goals for your treatment. If needed, you will be referred to additional services. The assessment process is designed to capitalize on the strengths and natural supports you have to further aid your recovery.

<u>Care Management/Skills Training:</u> Care managers lead weekly groups and provide one-on-one assistance helping you learn the skills that can keep you independent. Things a care manager can help you with may include: Symptom Management; Improving Your Relationships; Training to Ride TARC; Employment Empowerment; Improving School Performance; Food Planning and Preparation; Managing Diabetes on a Budget; Finding and Keeping a Home; Financial Management; Implementing New Parenting Strategies; Establishing a Schedule for Your Child; and Coping with Quitting Smoking, among other topics.

<u>Primary Care Services</u>: Primary Care services are available at several LifeSpring locations. We can provide comprehensive preventative care, in addition to providing treatment during illness. Our primary care providers see patients of all ages.

<u>Therapy:</u> During therapy, you will work with a therapist and you may work with clients similar to you. Group therapy provides a unique opportunity to meet other clients who have faced similar challenges, and learn about tools and treatments together. During individual therapy, you will work one-on-one with a therapist to make progress in your personal recovery.

Jeff Book: LifeSpring operates a used bookstore, called Jeff Book. It is a transitional work program, meaning that it gives LifeSpring clients an opportunity to try working again, in a positive and supportive environment. The program builds confidence, and gives experience in working on a computer, and dealing with customers and a supervisor.

<u>Psychiatric Medical and Nursing Services</u>: If after engagement in other services, the clinician believes it is appropriate for you to be referred to a physician, LifeSpring has a full staff of nurses, nurse practitioners and physicians ready to help you with stabilization and medication management.
