Quick Response Team

The Harrison County Quick Response
Team is a collaborative effort involving
law enforcement, mental health
providers, medical care providers, and
first responders. It's designed to provide
support to individuals within 24 to 72
hours following an overdose.. This is
considered the "recovery window", a
time when individuals with a substance
use disorder are thought to be more
open to accepting help. The Project
CARE initiative links individuals to
treatment right at their doorstep,
turning a crisis into an opportunity.
