Projects for Assistance in Transition from Homelessness (PATH) Program



What is PATH?

The Projects for Assistance in Transition from Homelessness (PATH) program provides services to people with serious mental illness, including those with co-occurring substance use disorders, who are experiencing homelessness or at imminent risk of becoming homeless.



Who is eligible?

To qualify for the PATH program, an individual must be:

1) determined to be experiencing serious mental illness or co-occurring serious mental illness and substance abuse disorder

AND

2) experiencing homelessness or at imminent risk of homelessness.

What services are available?

- Case management
- Mental health services
- Alcohol and drug treatment
 - Primary care services
 - Service coordination
 - Referral services
 - Benefits acquisition
- Representative payee services
